FOURTH WITNESS STATEMENT OF COMMISSIONER OF POLICE RICHARD ULLGER

- 1. My name is Richard Ullger, and I am the Commissioner of Police. I am in my 35th year of police service and have been the Commissioner since July 2020.
- 2. I make this fourth statement in response to the evidence provided today Wednesday the 8th of May 2024, by Nick Pyle, when he suggested that Police Motor Boat Sir John Chapple was weaponised by the RGP, referring to the 'log defender' which had been fitted to the front of the vessel.
- 3. I also make this statement in response to questions made to Dr Joey Britto, the Chairman of the Gibraltar Police Authority, by Sir Peter Caruana on Friday the 3rd of May 2024, in relation to the same matter
- 4. The attached letter, to the Chief Minister, dated the 4th of June 2020, explains the matter and will be of assistance to the inquiry in relation to the Incident at Sea Issue No3, as the key reason for loss of confidence in Ian McGrail by Mr Nick Pyle.
