
**WITNESS STATEMENT OF CHIEF INSPECTOR
ALEXANDER MANUEL ENRILES**

1. My name is Alexander Manuel Enriles and I am a Chief Inspector within the Royal Gibraltar Police currently attached to the Operations Division.
2. I have been requested by Superintendent Mark Wyan to provide this statement in relation to my current work phone, an I-Phone SE, telephone number 56199007.
3. I was promoted to the rank of Chief Inspector in 2021, the same year when Superintendent Paul Richardson retired. Prior to his retirement, on a date I cannot specifically recall, I had a conversation with Mr Richardson about acquiring his phone once he left the service, as he was assigned an I-Phone which would have to be returned upon retirement and as part of my role, I was going to be allocated a work phone too.
4. I was particularly interested on the possibility of being assigned his phone because it was an I-Phone, which is what I have personally used and prefer, when the majority of all other work phones were Samsung.
5. As a result, Mr Richardson handed the phone over to me once he left in 2021, I cannot recall exactly when. I then made the request to the RGP ITLD Officer at the time to ensure that the phone was ready for my use when the time came. I was subsequently given an I-Phone SE as my work phone, which I still have to date. It is my honestly held

belief that this is the same phone that Mr Richardson had immediately prior to his retirement.
